

Cabernet Sauvignon...

Surprisingly enough Cabernet Sauvignon is not one of the oldest wine grape varieties in the world. Research at the University of California at Davis found an unexpected relationship showing Cabernet Franc and Sauvignon Blanc to be Cabernet Sauvignon's parents and that Cabernet Sauvignon is less than 600 years old, a relative newcomer in the wine grape world. The oldest recorded reference to Cabernet Sauvignon comes from the 18th Century and Chateau Mouton.
