

Un-drunk, Open Wine Bottles...

It may not always be possible to finish a full bottle in one sitting, so what do you do to preserve the wine? How long will it last once it's been opened?

- Cork it immediately and put it in the refrigerator. Most wines will retain their flavor for a 48 hour period*.
- Use a Vacu-Vin sealer (available at Mountainside Wine!) which pumps air out of the bottle. Wine will last for almost one week*.
- Add an inert gas preserver (available at Mountainside Wine!) which displaces the oxygen and gives your wine another week* of life.

*these times are approximate and depend on the wine, temperatures and the amount of oxygen displaced.
